		<i>Ordered Steps</i>
		1. Report Primary Smoke Boundary.
		2. Space name(s), number(s) and frame number(s).
		3. Location within space (deck, bulkhead, overhead, port, stbd, forward, aft).
		4. Ventilation closures.
		5. Hazards (flammables, smoke, heat, fumes).
		6. Risk (vertical, adjacent, below).
		7. Move to <i>Set Phase</i> .

CASUALTY CHECK-LIST

		<i>Set Steps</i>
		1. Set Primary Smoke Boundary.
		2. Primary boundary - where you are going to make your stand against the casualty. (Use the ship to assist in rebuilding the box).
		3. Protective equipment (battle dress, SCBA, OBA, EEBD, fire boots) as required.
		4. Equipment (smoke blankets, smoke curtains).
		5. Communications with command and control (any means available: J-dial, sound powered phone, radios).
		6. Preparation: put up curtains and blankets; shut doors and hatches.
		7. Indications of smoke (heat, smell, hot spots).
		8. Report when boundary set.
		9. Monitor boundary.
		10. Report for debrief when relieved or secured.

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
